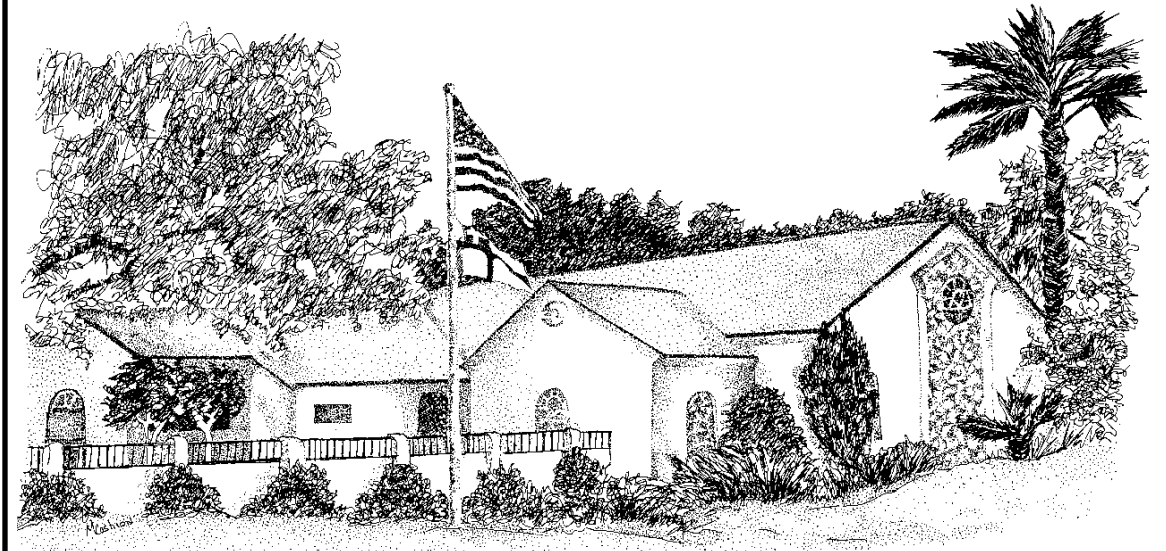

### **ST. ALBAN'S CRUISE TRIP**

Our own Sondra Colonel has put together some information for a possible St. Alban's Cruise weekend fun trip. She has provided two options:

#### **Option 1**

Friday January 8—Monday January 11, 2027. Ship- ***Celebrity Reflection*** leaving out of Ft. Lauderdale to Key West, Coco Cay and Ft. Lauderdale

Total cost for two guests is from \$1,463-\$1,700 depending on the location of the cabin and this includes cruise fare, drink package, gratuities and Wi-Fi.

For families with two children but no drink package or Wi-Fi, cost is \$1,463-\$1,772.

Brightline train round-trip to Ft. Lauderdale is appx \$150.00 per person.

#### **Option 2**

Friday January 29 —February 1, 2027.

Ship- ***Utopia*** leaving out of Port Canaveral to Nausau, Coco Cay, and Port Canaveral

Total cost for two guests is from \$1,289-\$1,843 depending on the location of the cabin and this includes cruise fare and gratuities.

For families with two children cost is \$1,945-\$2,665.24 depending on location of the cabin.

St. Alban's would receive a \$50.00 donation for each cabin booked. If we have 16 cabins booked, one cabin for two people could cruise for free or the value would be donated to the church.
